This position requires a self-motivated, safety conscious individual who takes great pride in their work. Responsibilities may include, but not be limited to the following:

- Provide leadership in safety by demonstrating and ensuring the adherence to company safety processes and procedures
- Familiar with all aspects of silviculture management (surveys, tree planting, site preparation, vegetation management, etc.) and operational implementation
- Complete and supervise field activities (i.e. surveys, tree planting, site assessments, etc.) as required
- Ability to work without supervision and manage multiple projects in a timely and cost-effective manner
- Manage and administer contracts to ensure services provided meet contracted specifications and requirements
- Provide expertise in monitoring and updating database information in various client databases and reporting systems such as Cengea, Phoenix, LRM, RESULTS
- Maintain accurate records and data necessary for purposes of demonstrating due diligence and as required by the Environmental Management System or other relevant certification schemes of our varied clients
- Prepare and sign/seal reports
- Provide continued support to our clients and maintain good working relationships
- Attend or lead meetings as required

QUALIFICATIONS

- A Registered Professional Forester (RPF) or be eligible for registration as an RPF with the Association of BC Forest Professionals (ABCFP) and two years (gained within the last five years) of experience in operational forestry specifically in silviculture. Considerations will be given for Registered Forest Technologists
- Experience with silviculture surveys (e.g. plantability, regeneration, free-to-grow in both single and multi-layered stands) would be an asset
- Registration as an BC Accredited Silviculture Surveyor would be an asset
- A strong understanding of silviculture and treatments (e.g. surveying, planting, brushing)
- Forestry field experience related to silviculture, forest ecology and forest management
- A strong work ethic, team oriented and a desire to develop and learn
- A high degree of organizational skills and attention to detail is required
- Physically fit and capable of producing in a physically demanding outdoor environment
- Possess a valid BC Driver's Licence with a clean driving record and experience driving forestry resource roads
