BC Timber Sales (BCTS) was founded in 2003 with a mandate to provide the cost and price benchmarks for timber harvested from public land in British Columbia. BCTS plans, develops, and auctions as much as 20% of the province's annual available volume. The bid prices received from auctioned timber and costs of developing the timber are available to support market pricing of the province's timber.

The Engineering Specialist's responsibilities encompass planning and coordinating the engineering program within the BA; development of operational plans; and meeting program objectives. Specific accountabilities include forest road and bridge engineering design coordination and review, senior professional advice and guidance on resource road authorizations, and development and implementation of the engineering budget.

Qualifications for this role include:

- A degree or diploma in forest engineering, forest management, engineering or equivalent related field and two years (gained within the last five years) of experience in road, bridge and major structures design, construction and maintenance.
OR
An equivalent combination of education and experience such as five years (gained within the last ten years) of experience in road, bridge and major structures design, construction and maintenance.
- Applicants must be registered or eligible for registration with the Association of British Columbia Forest Professionals (ABCFFP) as a:
 - Registered Professional Forester,
 - **OR** another applicable professional (i.e. PENG) eligible to hold a special practice permit with the ABCFFP.
- Experience in contract and or project management.
- Experience in managing complex road and or bridge construction projects.
