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Position Title: Area Forester

Key Responsibilities: The Area Forester works under the direction and supervision of the Operations Manager and Forestry Manager and is responsible for completing timber development and assisting with forestry operations within a defined area. Focus must be maintained on compliance with legislation, cost control and adherence to budgets and company goals.

TIMBER DEVELOPMENT

- Conduct or lead timber identification.
- Complete or lead timber reconnaissance.
- Maintain the information sharing process with First Nations and stakeholders.
- Maintain proforma models throughout timber development process and forestry operations.
- Entry of development information into Phoenix data system.
- Supervise and administer development contracts.
- Mentor Planning Foresters and Forest Technicians.
- Direct development consultants and Forest Technicians through block and road layout.
- Complete, co-ordinate and peer review all required assessments.
- Complete and peer review block and road Site Plans.
- Lead stumpage estimation.
- Complete cutting/road permit acquisition.

FORESTRY OPERATIONS

- Collaborate with Operations Foresters to generate logging plans.
- Supervise and administer plans and contracts pertaining to logging, road building, bridge installations and deactivation.
- Complete harvest inspections and monitor log quality.
- Ensure all operational post-harvest obligations are completed.
- Adhere to company safety practices.
- Assist with planning silviculture programs
- Complete Site Plan corrections and amendments; and silviculture milestone declarations.

Education:

- ABCFP Registered Professional Forester or Registered Forest Technologist designation is required.
- Undergraduate degree or technical diploma in Forestry or natural resources field is preferred.

Experience:

- Five years or more of experience in Forestry.

Personal Attributes:

- Must be flexible, organized and possess excellent time management skills.
- Must be decisive, assertive and able to negotiate contracts and contract amendments.
- Communication skills, via multiple media are critical to this position. Area Foresters must be able to effectively direct multi-disciplinary teams tasked with timber development and forestry operations.
- Must be familiar with BC Forestry Legislation, Regulations and Policy & Practices.
- Ability to work with little or no supervision.
