Responsibilities

- conducting road reconnaissance for annual monitoring / adequate signage; preparing pre-work for construction work; verifying contractor payment and compliance

- collect data using GPS and query / compile data using GIS system
- miscellaneous duties such as sign installation, bridge inspections, culvert inventory and other forestry related duties

Previous GIS, GPS, construction, field surveying (gravel pit and/or road layout, hydrology, FRI cruising) contractor supervision, surveying or harvesting experience would be an asset.
