EACOM currently owns seven sawmills (5 in Ontario, 2 in Quebec), a remanufacturing facility (Quebec) and a partnership operation in an engineered I-joists plant (Ontario). Its head office is located in Montreal, Quebec, and the company is now hiring more than 1 000 passionate people. The Company is committed to investing in strong assets, including healthy forests, advanced technology and talented people.

We are presently looking for a Woodlands Contractor Operations Supervisor for our Nairn Center Sawmill in Ontario. Reporting to the Nairn Center Woodland Superintendant, you will be responsible for organizing and executing the annual delivery of 100,000 m3 of SPF to the Nairn Center sawmill including up to an additional 50,000 m3 of external sales, the majority of the work for the supervisor will be on the EACOM operations on the Northshore Forest West.

You will organize a number of contractors and owner operators performing road construction, harvesting and hauling.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Implement a yearly harvest and delivery program of approximately 150,000 m3 that meets the inventory and quality requirements of the Nairn Center sawmill and external sales customers.
- Supervise forest operations for safety, environment and product quality standards for road building, harvest, and haul operations.
- Perform road layout and planning advance road construction.
- Ensure operations are in compliance with the forest management plan, all related provincial and federal laws and regulations.
- Perform all scheduled Environmental Management System (EMS) audits and develop and implement action plans associated with audit findings.
- Ensure conformance to all 3rd party certification systems.
- Manage contractor road construction to meet the current and future access needs to sustain the harvest of 150,000 m3 annually.
- Coordinate log haul (trucks and loaders) to meet inventory targets for the Nairn Center Sawmill.
- Ensure full compliance with all Government & Company policies, rules and regulations with respect to health and safety and the environment.

SKILLS PROFILE

- Have leadership skills, be motivated to produce high-quality deliverable products, and be flexible and adaptable to a variety of work environments.
- Strong beliefs and behaviors in safety and environmental values and results.
- Have the ability to work in a professional manner; independently and with minimal supervision in a team environment.
- Strong organizational skills and ability to prioritize tasks and time.
- Demonstrate a willingness to learn, a positive attitude, be physically fit, and able to produce positive results with clients and contractors.

REQUIREMENTS

- 4 to 8 years experience in the field of forestry operations with a minimum of four years in a supervisor's position;

- Relevant Forestry or Business education or experience to complement the position requirements
- Intimate knowledge of road layout and construction, timber harvesting, processing and hauling operations.
- Clear understanding of the legislative requirements affecting forest management in Ontario and the Occupational Health and Safety Act.
- Experienced in the use of Microsoft Office and GPS technology;
- Proven ability building strong relationships with contractors, owner operators, communities and government agencies.
- Required to work outdoors in a variety of weather conditions; must be able to travel over all terrain conditions encountered in the forest
- Valid Driver's license.
