



Mechanical Harvesting Supervisors and Field Supervisors

Mechanical Harvesting Supervisor

The successful candidate for this position will be a hard working individual with past experience in cut-to-length harvesting with rubber tired equipment. Attention to detail and great organizational skills are a priority as the projects involve selective harvesting on Municipal lands in a very high use area. Mechanical aptitude is a strong advantage as well as field skills including block planning, gps/mapping skills, and dealing with the public. Formal forestry training is beneficial but is not a mandatory requirement.

Field Supervisor

The Field Supervisor role is a field-based position with responsibilities for the safety, quality, production, cost and environmental performance of manual chainsaw crews. The successful candidate will be responsible for managing all crew issues on a daily basis and utilizing the individual skills to achieve team results. The crews will be either performing FireSmart or Mountain Pine Beetle control work or a combination of both. Current Faller certification under Enform or Woodland Trainers Association is a plus as is a formal forestry education and chainsaw experience is mandatory.

Wages and Schedule

The wages for both roles are paid on a day-rate basis and dependent on experience; we strive for above average compensation within the forest industry with the level intended to be on the high end for the forest industry. The work schedule is flexible with days off scheduled in advance for the Supervisors.
