This position requires leadership and commitment to our safety and environmental management systems.

Specific responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

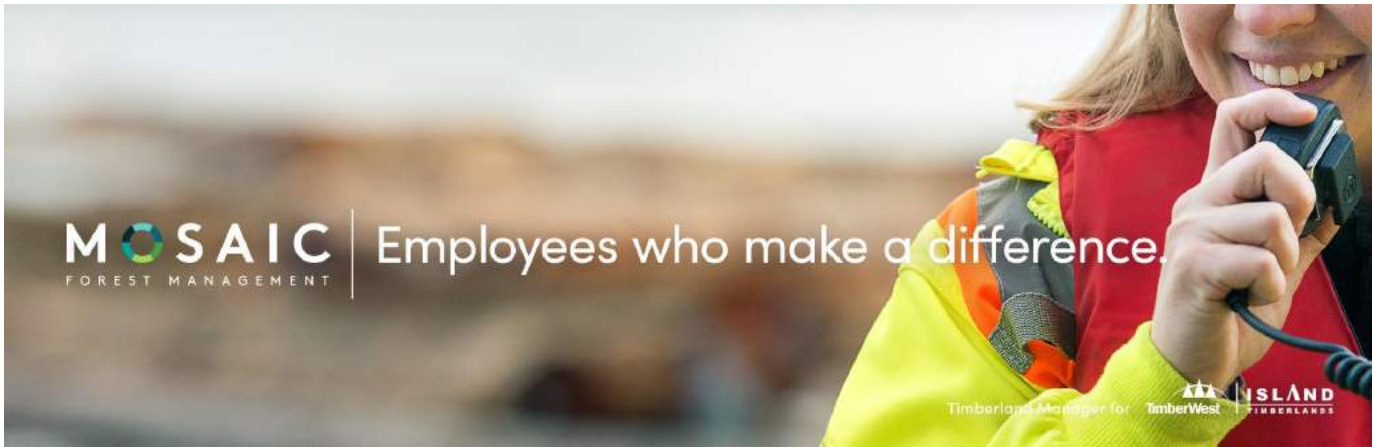
- > Provide leadership in safety through personal example, with a strong focus on achieving world-class performance in safety and adhering to living and promoting Mosaic Values on a daily basis. Safety is a key focus of everyone at Mosaic.
- > Direct, delegate and plan projects, field layout, survey, map and design with Contract Engineers and Operations Planners.
- > Ensure all permit applications required to execute the logging and road building activities are in place to allow operational continuity and flexibility.
- > Ensure the quality of cut block layout and block files through audits of contract engineering work, and deliver plans and the signed-off cut blocks to Contract Managers in a timely manner.
- > Provide leadership in the safe execution of the planned harvest where necessary.
- > Work in alignment with the Forest Hydrology and Infrastructure team to coordinate the design, installation, inspection, assurance and maintenance of bridges.

- > Assist the Operations team with short-term and long-term operational planning, annual budgeting, contract management systems, negotiating rates, and resolving operational issues.
- > Maintain and foster good relationships with First Nations, government agencies, and industry players to preserve and enhance Mosaics' position within the industry and the overall community.
- > Be available to provide vacation relief coverage for Contract Managers.

### Required Skills and Experience

- > Accreditation with the ABCFP as a Registered Professional Forester, or a Registered Forest Technologist (or RPF/RFT eligible). Preference will be given to applicants with an RPF designation.
- > 7 – 10 years' coastal forest engineering experience.
- > Demonstrated ability to work effectively in a team environment.
- > Leadership capacity in safety and environmental stewardship.
- > Demonstrated personal health and safety as a priority and is in good physical condition.
- > Aptitude in Microsoft, ROADENG, GIS, LIDAR, GPS, ARCMAP based mapping and other evolving computer applications.
- > Demonstrated competence in cut block layout and practical knowledge of timber harvesting systems for old-growth and second-growth, timber quality and value, and an understanding of the applicable regulations, legislation and certification systems (ISO 14001 and SFI) are required.
- > Ability to self-direct and effectively organize, plan work and prioritize resources to deliver divisional and departmental plans and activities.
