POSITION AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure work orders for maintenance activities are complete.
- Oversee the development and training of maintenance apprentices in accordance with company standards and the Saskatchewan Apprenticeship and Trade Certification Commission.
- Schedule and expand upon the plant's preventative maintenance program to improve our ability to predict equipment downtime before failure occurs resulting in improved Plant uptime.
- Create a culture of continuous improvement in all departments of the plant.
- Make recommendations for equipment replacement as observed and required.
