Reporting to the Manager of the Landscape Protection Unit, Parks Division and located in Regina, a primary role of the Senior Park Landscape Ecologist will be to provide scientific-based direction and advice to Landscape Protection Unit staff, executive management and park managers on landscape health and ecological protection for the provincial park system. In addition, other duties include, but are not limited to the development and implementation of ecosystem-based management plans, management of climate change adaptation and providing for species at risk management on provincial park lands.

Typically, the knowledge and skills for this position would be obtained through a Master's degree and or PhD in forestry and/or prairie grassland ecology, resource management planning, biodiversity conservation or other related fields of study and several years of progressively responsible experience with ecosystem/environmental management or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

The successful candidate will be required to travel to remote locations to conduct work activities, work irregular hours, conduct field studies/research and assessments and will be required to operate four wheel drive trucks, all-terrain vehicles and small motorized boats. A valid class five driver's license is required. The successful applicant will be required to travel occasionally in small fixed winged and rotary winged aircraft to perform work duties.
