## GIS Forester

As a **GIS Forester**, you will show exceptional creativity and initiative in supporting the forest management team. You will provide production support for forest management plans, operational plans, and silviculture. Duties will include supervising the collection and analysis of growth and yield data, preparation of inventory and modeling data, mapping, data maintenance, and analyses. A significant portion of your time will be spent developing GIS solutions. Your excellent communication skills will be required daily and you will represent the company in front of government, public, and external organizations. You will manage large individual responsibility within a dynamic team environment.

Preference may be given to those individuals with skills and/or aptitude to perform timber supply modeling.
