



**Field Operations Coordinator
(Permanent - Full Time)**

EACOM currently owns eight sawmills in Ontario and Quebec, and employs more than 1,100 employees.

EACOM (as Agent for Northshore Forest Inc.) provides forest management services on the Northshore Forest. We are currently looking to hire a Field Operations Coordinator working out of our Thessalon office.

Duties:

- Based out of the Thessalon office and reporting to the Superintendent of Forestry you will assist in the planning, implementation and monitoring of all silvicultural activities on the Northshore Forest.
- Assist the Management Forester to develop Annual Work Schedules consistent with approved Forest Management Plans and operating budgets.
- Ensure all operations are consistent with FSC certification standards for the Northshore Forest.
- Monitor and report on the compliance of harvest, road construction and silviculture operations.
- Assist Overlapping Licencees and Contractors during the implementation of harvest operations
- Liaise with the Ministry of Natural Resources, Shareholders and Overlapping Licencees.

Qualifications:

The successful candidate will:

- Possess 5+ years of related forestry experience (forest management experience in the Great Lakes-St. Lawrence Region would be considered an asset);
- Have a recognized University Degree or College Diploma in forestry or it's equivalent;
- Demonstrate a willingness to learn, a positive attitude, be physically fit, and able to produce positive results;
- Have leadership skills, be motivated to produce high-quality deliverable products, and be flexible and adaptable to a variety of work environments;
- Have the ability to work independently with minimal supervision and in a team environment;
- Be experienced in the use of Microsoft Office, Arcview GIS (or equivalent), GPS technology and electronic data collection tools;
- Be a certified MNR Compliance Inspector and Tree Marker or possess the ability to obtain certification;
- Have a reliable 4-wheel drive vehicle and valid Ontario "G" Class Drivers License, or equivalent, clean driving record and experience with driving on gravel roads;
