## **Senior Forestry Engineer**

The Senior Forestry Engineer will be reporting to the Planning Manager and will be responsible for the following:

- Assisting in field layout, quality control, and crew supervision;
- assisting in cutting permit, road permit and various other permit preparation;
- meeting timelines and budget targets;
- assisting in crew scheduling;
- assisting in mapping preparation;
- preparing and releasing harvest and road building packages and;
- assisting in silviculture prescription preparation; and

The requirements for the position are as follows:

- Post-secondary education with a degree or technical diploma in a forestry related field would be considered an asset but not necessary;
- a member of or eligible for registration in the Association of BC Forest Professionals would be considered an asset but not necessary;
- minimum 3 years of coastal layout experience;
- must be very organized, physically fit, have good communication skills, self motivated, and have the ability to work effectively under minimal supervision;
- must have some experience preparing road permits and collecting appraisal data for cutting permit submissions;
- use of Roadeng software, ArcGIS and MS Office.
- experience running a boat would be considered an asset but not necessary;

- have a valid BC Driver's licence.
