Spectrum provides expertise and professional services specializing in Forest Management, Forest Health, Vegetation Management, Reforestation and Biology. Positions exist within our operations centered in Prince George and Chetwynd, BC for the following: Forest Technologists: Summer Student (May - August) and Full Time Technologist Positions. The successful candidates will perform a variety of fieldwork, focusing on silviculture surveys, layout for herbicide applications, site preparation, planting and brushing and contract implementation of vegetation management activities. Following the silviculture field season candidates may continue their employment completing bark beetle probes and other bark beetle management contracts.

Qualifications:

The ideal candidate will have completed the second year of a Resource Management Degree or completed a Forestry Technical Diploma, candidates with lesser education will be considered. Preference will be given to candidates who have: completed silviculture studies, have experience performing silviculture surveys or utilizing the Biogeoclimatic Ecological Classification System for site identification and who have experience performing or implementing silviculture reforestation treatments. Accreditation as a Silviculture Surveyor, a valid first aid ticket or possession of a pesticide applicator license are all assets, but not required. Upon commencement of employment, candidates are expected to possess basic forestry field skills, including compass operation, map reading and plant and tree identification. The position is primarily field oriented and is well suited to physically fit; self motivated individuals with strong organization and problem solving skills. Although the positions are centered around Chetwynd, shift work in trailer camps will also be necessary. The successful candidates will be required to possess a valid driver's license and have the ability to operate 4WD trucks and off road vehicles. Candidates with strong silviculture fieldwork experience and leadership skills have the potential to immediately advance into leadership roles. The potential also exists for proficient candidates to advance to full time, permanent positions. Compensation is primarily production based with the average technologist earning \$1500 - \$1800 bi-weekly.
