Established in 1985, Waugh's Woods Ltd. is a long term Forest Products and Forestry services company based in The Pas, Manitoba.

Forestry services operations include forest data collection and management involving Regeneration Surveys, Free to Grow Surveys, Pre Harvest Forest Investigations, Harvest Boundary and Road Layout, Winter Road Layout, Photo Interpretation and associated stand classification and planning. Growth in the mining sector has recently provided work outside the realm of traditional Forest Data Collection and this area continues to develop.

Seasonal positions start immediately and end August 31, 2010. People interested in longer term work are encouraged to apply as well. These positions offer a great deal of challenge and experience working in the boreal forest. Successful candidates will end the season having become experienced in most, if not all, of the work mentioned above.

All applicants should have or be working on education and experience which qualifies them for this work. Some of the data collection methods require Provincial Certification by Manitoba Conservation. Prerequisites include sufficient skill in:

- Navigation (compassing, chaining, GPS, map work, and air photo interpretation)
- Shrub and Tree identification
- Organization and Record Keeping
- Valid First Aid with C.P.R. certificate is required
- Pleasure Craft Operator's Card is required (info online, Transport Canada – Office of Boating Safety – Pleasure Craft Operator Card).

A valid driver's license with clean driving record are mandatory and experience operating A.T.V's and boats are assets, but not required.

A positive attitude, strong work ethic, and willingness to carry out a large variety of field work in all weather conditions, will indicate appropriate candidates. Work is in north central Manitoba. Remuneration is a daily rate. Generally, seasonal work is performed on a 10 days on, 4 days off schedule. This schedule is subject to change influenced by weather, access, and accommodations. Candidates must be willing to stay in camp, motels etc. and to travel in small aircraft / helicopters, boats, trucks, and A.T.V's.
