- Provide Area team leadership in the delivery of Timber Revenue and Production Monitoring program.

- Provide ongoing support and training to the Forest Officers and Foresters as it related to assigned duties.
- Provide support to Wildfire Management program as required.
- Participate in issue management activities as required.
- Assist in the field monitoring and identification of forest insects and disease as requested by the Senior Forester.
