

Forest Technician required for dynamic and engaging position.

Title: Field Technician

Job description: The field technician typically works in a group of 2, though the right candidate may be authorized to do solo work. The right candidate is hard working, self motivated, able to work independently as well as part of a team and is an excellent communicator both verbally and in writing.

The work primarily consists of conducting detailed site analyses on private land blocks ranging from 160 to 80 acres in size. The information required from these assessments includes:

- Species composition
- Approximate stand delineation
- Average diameters per stand
- Soil classification
- Topography mapping including calculating slope

The information gathered during the assessment will then be transferred into a property report and submitted for review. This information is used for identifying the highest and best use of the property that has been assessed and management and land use decisions regarding that property will be made based on the results of the assessment as documented in the report.

Other tasks that our Field Technician will be engaged in:

- Moisture monitoring of harvested biomass and the maintenance of a biomass information database
- Reconciliation of BOLs with mill slips
- Road locating for biomass or logging operations

- Some supervision of logging or biomass operations
