The Forestry Supervisor will work as part of a team responsible for conducting sustainable forest management operations, including the safe, timely and cost-efficient delivery of logs and fibre to our lumber, pulp and specialty wood products facilities. Responsibilities will vary depending on individual qualifications, but may include:

- coordination of harvesting, log haul, and log loading.
- implementation of planting, site preparation, regeneration survey, stand tending and pre-commercial thinning operations
- coordination of growth and yield programs
- supervision of road reclamation activities
- budgeting and forecasting;
- annual and five-year development plans;
- ensuring operations are carried out in an environmentally sensitive manner, in accordance with sustainable forest management practices.

Ideal applicants will have a post-secondary education in forestry, combined with silviculture and/or operations experience. Candidates must be eligible for registration with the Association of Alberta Forest Management Professionals (AAFMP). Strong interpersonal, communication and organizational skills are essential. Successful candidates will require the ability to work cooperatively with contractors and stakeholders, in addition to working independently in a field environment.
