



Job Posting – SFL General Manager

Nipissing Forest Resource Management Inc. (NFRM) and the Vermilion Forest Management Company Ltd. (VFM) are the Sustainable Forest Licence (SFL) holders for the Nipissing Forest and Sudbury Forest, respectively. The SFLs are responsible for forest management planning, forest renewal and compliance processes on the management units. The Forests are within the transition zone between the Great Lakes-St. Lawrence and the Boreal Forest regions around North Bay and the City of Greater Sudbury and they offer an interesting and challenging range of forest stand conditions.

The successful candidate will report to the Boards of Directors of both VFM and NFRM and will manage and participate on the forest management teams to support current operations, planning, and implementation of work plans.

This is a unique position for an individual who can provide hands-on support and effective management to the individual SFL companies. The position is available to start immediately, working in a transition with the current General Manager. Salary is competitive and will be based on current career experience.

Duties:

- The General Manager is responsible for the overall success of NFRM and VFM including:
 - Managing the day-to-day operations of both companies,
 - Representing both companies in their relationship with the Ministry of Natural Resources and Forestry,
 - Ensuring that each company fulfills the requirements and obligations of their Sustainable Forest Licence,
 - Provide planning, staffing, and direction to ensure the delivery of work plans,
 - Maintain regular and open communication with directors of NFRM and VFM.
 - Producing specific products to support the ongoing businesses, forest operators and employees.

- Demonstrated success in business leadership,
- Demonstrated commitment to high professional standards of ethics and integrity,
- Demonstrated success in contract negotiations, management and implementation related to natural resource and/or forestry activities,
