- Proficient with ArcGIS Online and ESRI suite of extensions. Data management, Python, and remote imagery
 processing experience is considered an asset.
- Familiarity with BC Government Electronic Forest Management, ESF submissions, RESULTS, Phoenix or EZ preferred.
- Familiarity with GPS, Pathfinder Office, OnPOZ GNSS, TerraSync, SoftTree and BCTS (BC Gov) systems like LRM database would be an asset.
- IT experience, including backup systems, file management, software installation, network management, and tablet maintenance would be an asset.

- Registration with the Forest Professionals of BC (FPBC) as an RFT, RPF, FIT, or TFT is preferred but not required.

 map templates and other configurations as required, analyze and document business processes and assist in
 developing standards and procedures.
- Produce and maintain operational maps from standard map templates, produce maps for operational and tactical planning initiatives. Produce refined final submission maps for various clients.
- Undertake GPS data storage, management, and GPS program development.
- Provide critical thinking support, company support, and policy direction for team development.
- Provide tech support to field staff.
