Responsibilities

Design/drafting: general arrangement and detailed designs for resource roads, bridges, retaining walls, log transfer facilities, marine structures and other infrastructure using AutoCAD Civil 3D; preparing technical reports and analysis, assisting with structural design and calculations; design flood hydrology and hydraulic analysis for stream crossing structures; site surveys using a total station and RTK GNSS equipment; bridge and structure inspections, assessments and repair/upgrade plans; construction supervision and set out; field work in rugged wilderness terrain and inclement weather, requiring travel to remote job sites

Qualifications

- Registered or eligible for registration with the Applied Science Technologist (AScT) with ASTTBC, or as a Registered Forest Technologist (RFT) or Registered Professional Forester (RPF) with ABCFP
- A recognized diploma in Civil Engineering or Forest Technology, or an equivalent combination of relevant education and experience - PEng designation an asset
- A great attitude and attention to detail; excellent client service, interpersonal and teamwork skills
- Excellent English oral/written communication
- Valid Class 5 BC Driver's License (or equivalent)
- Proficiency or working knowledge in design/ drafting using AutoCAD Civil 3D
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suite
