



Position Title: Log Procurement / Log Quality Supervisor

Reporting to: General Manager

Position Details: This newly created, Vancouver-based permanent salaried position, supports the General Manager in the management of both Company and contract logging operations, focused on log quality, safety and log inventory management. This role requires travel and has the potential to include log trading, for the right candidate.

Key Responsibilities:

- Ensure log quality controls, grading and scaling standards are achieved at Company and contract log sorts.
- Inspection of log booms, management of log inventories for Company operations, log supply agreements and manage internal and external sorts.
- Compile and record production volumes and support the accounting function to ensure accurate timely internal and external reporting.
- Assist with the negotiation and management of log trade agreements, correspond with logging contractors, scalers and the BC Ministry of Forests.

Qualifications:

- University degree, diploma or forest industry experience is required, RPF is nice to have but not required.
- Scaling license, experience managing a sort of yard is desirable, as well as knowledge of sorting / grading specifications and species identification.
- Working knowledge of the British Columbia Harvest Billing System.
- Strong interpersonal, verbal and written communication skills.
- High attention to detail, act with integrity and possess a positive “can-do” attitude.
- Proficient in MS Office, including MS Office, Outlook, Word, Excel, PowerPoint, comfortable working in team-based environments, as well as using collaborative applications such as Zoom, Teams, Google Meet or others.
