This is an active role that will involve regular travel to operating sites, log yards, dryland sorts and processing locations throughout the Campbell River and North Island area.

- Monitor, track and report on log and fibre quality from harvest through sorting, processing and delivery.
- Conduct regular quality inspections and audits.
- Work with all personnel throughout the supply chain to identify opportunities to improve value recovery and reduce downgrade, waste and fibre loss.
- Ensure customer specifications are understood and consistently achieved.
- Support accurate measurement, documentation and reporting of quality and production information.
- Communicate quality expectations clearly and professionally.
- Work collaboratively with operations rather than simply identifying problems.
- Help develop practical solutions that improve both quality and productivity.
- Support continuous improvement initiatives throughout the operation.
- Maintain compliance with applicable legislation, company policies and customer requirements.
